





The first step is visiting the pageant's website at www.JacksonvillePageants.com to check out the eligibility requirements. Depending on when your birthday falls, if you are a single lady ages 14 - 18, you may qualify for the Teen pageant, and if you are between the ages of 18 - 27, you may qualify for the Miss Pageant. There is an entry or sponsorship fee to enter the pageant, which you may pay or have a sponsor to pay for you. You will need to submit a headshot photo and paperwork, so visit the website to obtain the list of requirements and to print up the forms you will need to get signed up. The sign up process is quite easy, so don't be intimidated

You will need to be prepared to compete in three competitions: interview, swimsuit/fitness, and evening gown. Each category is judged equally by a well qualified panel of judges. There is usually a fun opening number at the beginning of the pageant for you to introduce yourself to the judges and the audience (which will be full of your cheering and supportive friends and family).
